

New SAS Professional Award

To be eligible for a New SAS Professional Award, you must:

- Be a full-time SAS professional who has less than five years of experience with SAS in a professional capacity. Using SAS as a student in a college/university does not count toward your five years of SAS professional experience.
- Have never attended a SAS Global Forum (attendance as a student does not count).
- Otherwise not be able to attend.
- Submit an abstract for an e-poster, Quick Tip or breakout session and if your abstract is accepted, you may also be eligible for four nights at the conference hotel.

If you are interested in submitting an abstract, a mentoring program is available. You can get help with your abstract, paper and presentation. See details about the mentoring program.

What the Award Covers

- Waived conference registration fee, including conference meals (up to a \$1,695 value).
- One free pre-conference tutorial (up to a \$175 value).
- If abstract accepted, eligible for four nights at the conference hotel.

International Professional Award

To be eligible for an International Professional Award, you must:

- Be a full-time SAS professional who works and resides outside the 48 contiguous states within the United States.
- Have never attended a SAS Global Forum (except as a student).
- Otherwise not be able to attend.
- Submit an abstract for an e-poster, Quick Tip or breakout session and if your abstract is accepted, you may also be eligible for:
 - · Four nights at the conference hotel.
 - Travel assistance.

If you are interested in submitting an abstract, a mentoring program is available. You can get help with your abstract, paper and presentation. See details about the mentoring program.

What the Award Covers

- Waived conference registration fee, including conference meals (up to a \$1,695 value).
- One free pre-conference tutorial (up to a \$175 value).
- If abstract accepted, eligible for four nights at the conference hotel and travel assistance.








Changes ? Yes and No
